

Brazos Animal Shelter Owner Surrender/Out of County Intake Form

Please fill out this form in as much detail as possible. Filling out this form **does not** insure your animal a place in our facility. Once we receive the application you will be notified that the application was received and you will also be given a quote for the surrender fee. This initial call is not for your appointment. We will keep the application on file for 30 days. During this time period you are still expected to look for other alternatives. There are many shelters and rescues to consider and it is up to you to research these options. We attempt to bring in animals in the order that the forms are received, however we also have to consider the size, breed, sex, age, health, and temperament of the animal in order to keep a variety of animals in the shelter. This helps us to adopt out animals in a timely manner. After 30 days, the application is automatically discarded. In addition to the form, you must also send a picture of the pet to kshaw@brazosanimalshelter.org with "surrender photo" in subject line. Include your name and the name of the animal in the text of the email to ensure we match the photo with the correct form. If an opening becomes available within the 30 day period, we will call you between the hours of 9am-10:30am to setup an appointment. During the appointment you must bring in current veterinary records including all shots given as well as recent FeLV/FIV test (within the last 60 days).
