Care Tech

This person would work a care technician for the animals. Care techs are responsible for the safe, sanitary and humane operations of the kennel facilities; the health and welfare of the animals in the care of the shelter; the delivery of the pets to local veterinarians, rabies testing facilities, other agency transfers; and other like tasks. Training will be provided on site. You must function within the goals set by the Executive Director and Board of Directors; act as a fully-integrated member of the Animal Shelter.

As a care tech intern, you will learn how to vaccinate/microchip the animals, basic animal handling and much more.

Photography

This person supports the Community Enhancement Coordinator and Humane Educator to maintain pictures for the many media outlets and websites. You must commit to taking pictures, creating descriptions and basic photo editing on a weekly basis. Training will be provided on site. You must function within the goals set by the Executive Director and Board of Directors; act as a fully-integrated member of the Animal Shelter.

As a photography intern, you will learn how to photograph pets, photo editing, enhance your writing skills and more.

Event Planning

This person supports the Community Enhancement Coordinator, which books off-premise adoption and community events. You must attend the events that are booked (weekends and some weekdays) and will receive on site training. You must function within the goals set by the Executive Director and Board of Directors; act as a fully-integrated member of the Animal Shelter.

As an event planning intern, you will learn how to plan, fundraise and execute events throughout the semester.
